Requirements to participate in the program:

- Be between 12 – 15 years of age
- Have a parent or legal guardian that is willing to volunteer as well
- Fill out a Volunteer Application, parent or legal guardian must also fill out an application
- Sign a Liability Release & Volunteer Agreement Form
- Attend a New Volunteer Orientation
- Attend a Buddy Session
- Be willing to commit to 3 hours of volunteer service in a 90-day period
